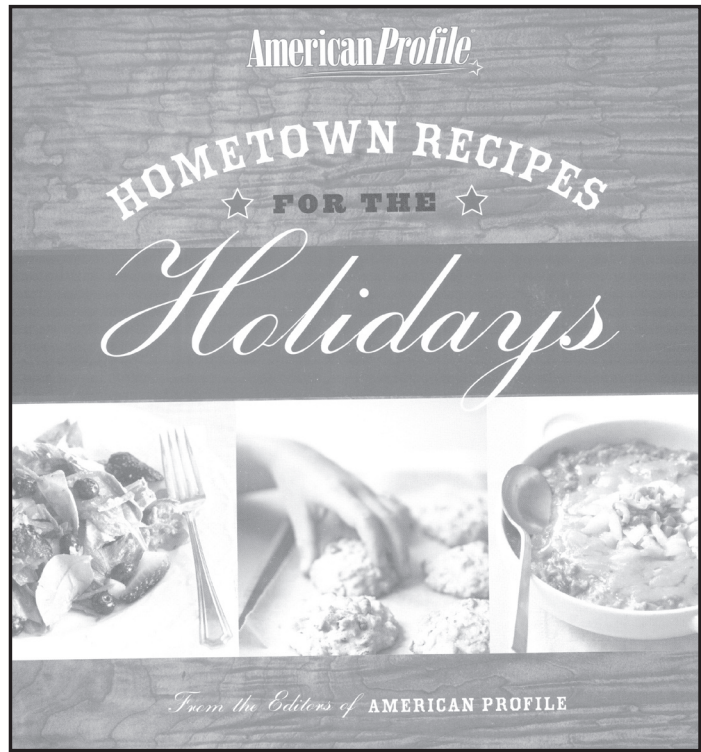

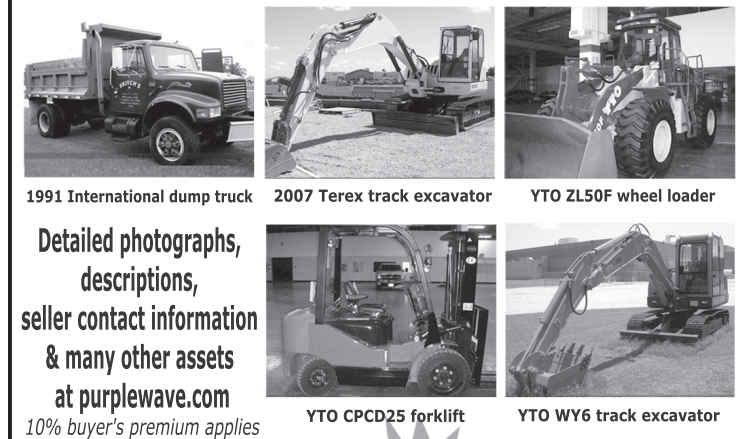

"Divine Prayers"

"During the days of Jesus' life on earth, He offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save Him from death, and He was heard because of His reverent submission." (Hebrews 5:7) During the days of Jesus' life on this earth, He prayed "Divine Petitions" that were for the honor of God, His Father.

The promises found in God's word are not to supersede prayers. They are to serve only as guides for our desires and are the grounds of our hope as we learn to pray as Jesus prayed. Christians are to look to Him and say, "Lord teach me to pray." (Luke 11:1)

Matthew Henry wrote: "The prayers and supplications that Christ offered up were joined with strong cries and tears, herein setting us an example not only to pray, but to be fervent and [be urgently persistent] in prayer." He also wrote, "All repetitions in prayer are not to be counted as vain repetitions..." The New International Dictionary tells us, "Prayer is the spiritual response, spoken or unspoken to God, who is known. Not merely to know He exists, but, He has revealed Himself and has invited His creation to have communion with Him. Thus prayer covers a wide spectrum of addressing and hearing God. Interceding with and waiting for the Lord as we petition our Father in heaven." The International Standard Bible Encyclopedia tells us that prayer is "Communion with God, usually comprising of petition, adoration, praise, confession and thanksgiving. The ultimate object of prayer in both Old and New Testament is not merely the good of the petitioner, but the honor of God's Name."

The only prayers that are heard or answered yes to, are those that are offered up for the glory of God. Salvation is given when people pray that God will glorify Himself in the redeeming of a sinful soul.

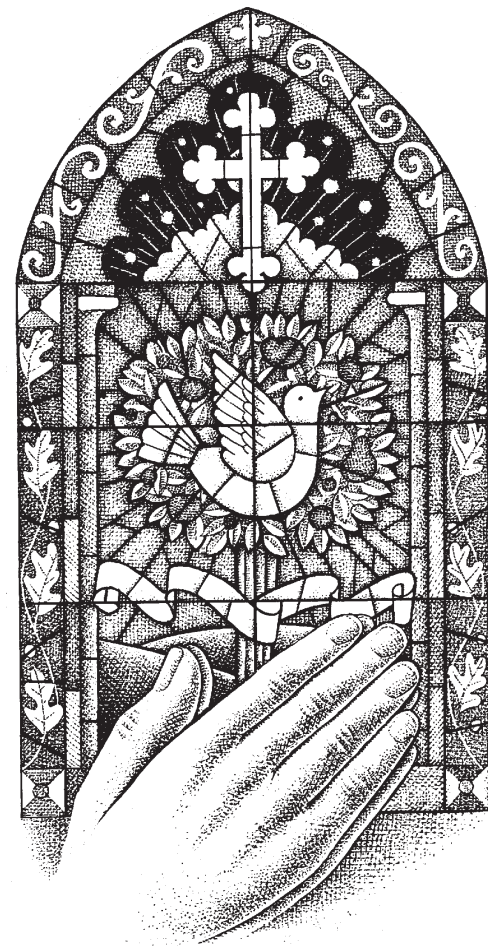
