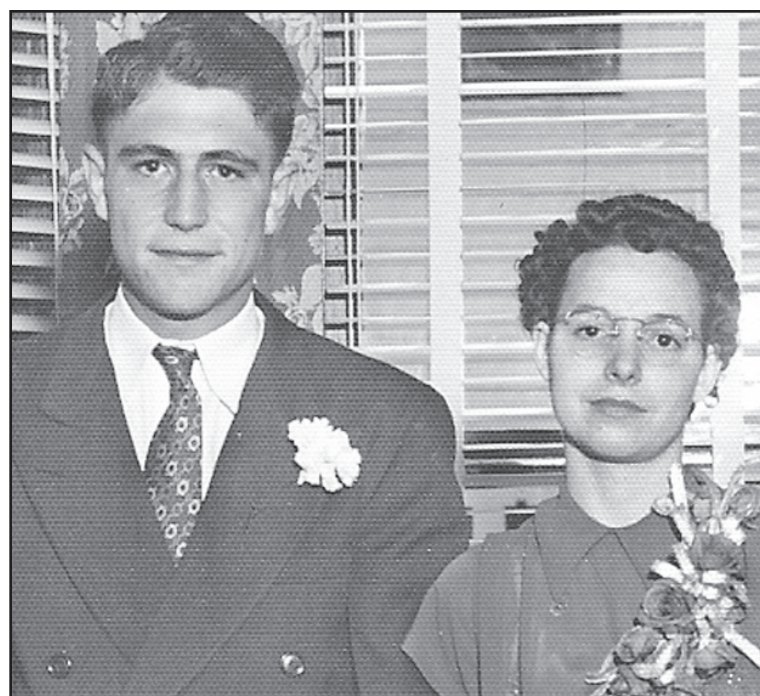


Taking a test drive
