"Sustaining Prayers of Christ"

The New Testament holds a terrible truth about two apostles who walked with Christ, one Judas, the second Peter. Judas failed Christ and Peter was sustained by Christ's prayer for him. The difference between Judas and Peter regarding their failures is, Judas could not trust in Jesus prayers offered for true believers in Him. (John 17:6-19) Peter did, thus he was empowered to achieve what Judas Iscariot could not do on his own.

In Luke 22:31-32 we read of the powerful prayer offered in Peter's behalf, "...the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not; and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren." Holy Spirit illuminated Christians grasp a powerful revelation presented in this passage of Scripture. In saying "you" (hymas) Jesus was referring to all the disciples and in saying "thee" (sou) our Lord was referring to Peter personally. These Christians know how desperately they need Jesus' prayers so they may overcome all

Matthew Henry wrote in exposition, "Peter, who used to be the mouth of the rest in speaking to Christ, is here made the ear of the rest and designed for warning them all." The more God wants to use a child of God and the more a Christian becomes useful in the building of the true church, the more Satan wants to destroy him and his works with the Lord.

Christ's prayer for Peter's "faith" not to "fail," empowered Peter to have a faith (pistis) which enabled him to trust in Christ and God's forgiveness. This faith gave Peter all he needed to achieve everything the Lord has called him to do. Peter's denial was serious and showed a shrinking in faith. Peter chose to believe and trust in Christ and God, not like Judas Iscariot whose faith did fail completely. Peter returned, but Judas Iscariot did not.

All of us have failed the Lord in some way. We gave into Satan as he used our flesh, a world view and even lies. Believing that Christ prays for us enables us to return into His service in full faith.


