RESOLUTION NO. 2009-19

Published in The Norton Telegram on Friday, September 25, 2009. (17)

A RESOLUTION REGULATING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON COUNTY ROAD "K" LYING BETWEEN COUNTY ROAD E-1 AND COUNTY ROAD E-2 WITHIN NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Kansas law grants Norton County, Kansas, jurisdiction as a local authority to regulate the operation of motor vehicles upon roadways within the County; and
WHEREAS, the nature of highway traffic on County Road K within the County has caused the County of Norton, Kansas, to take steps to accommodate and regulate increased vehicular traffic on a portion of Road K lying between County Road E-1 and County Road E-2.
BE IT RESOLVED, therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, as follows:
SECTION ONE: That the County road made subject of this resolution is described as follows:
County Road "K" lying between N County Road E-1 and County Road E-2 in Norton County, Kansas.
SECTION TWO: That traffic control devices shall be posted indicating that traffic shall proceed in one direction upon the County road.
SECTION THREE: That a vehicle shall be driven only in the direction designated at all or such time as shall be indicated by the traffic control devices.
SECTION FOUR: That enforcement of this resolution and punishments for its violation shall be governed by the Kansas Uniform Act regulating traffic, K.S.A. 8-1401, et seq.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution take effect upon its adoption and publication in the official County newspaper.
