#### ORDINANCE #259

An ordinance setting an election date on the question of adoption of Charter Ordinance #4 concerning the holding of appointive offices by non-residents

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Norcatour, Kansas:

**SECTION 1.** Charter Ordinance #4 was adopted by the Norcatour City Council on July 20, 2009 and the required publications were made of same.

**SECTION 2.** On September 16, 2009 a petition was filed with the city requesting an election on the issue of the adoption of said Charter Ordinance. Said petition has been validated by the county election officer and an election is required to be held pursuant to Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution.

**SECTION 3.** The election on the question of adoption of said Charter Ordinance is hereby scheduled for Dec. 15th, 2009.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be published once each week for three consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

*"Throne of A Sovereign God"*

A Key principle to enjoying the Throne of Grace is to rest on the fact that it is the throne of a Sovereign God. Psalm 103:19, says, "The Lord has established His throne in the heavens; And His sovereignty rules over all."

Sovereignty is a prerogative arising out of the perfection of the Supreme Being. God is Spirit (John 4:24) and therefore a Person, infinite, eternal, and immutable in His being.
