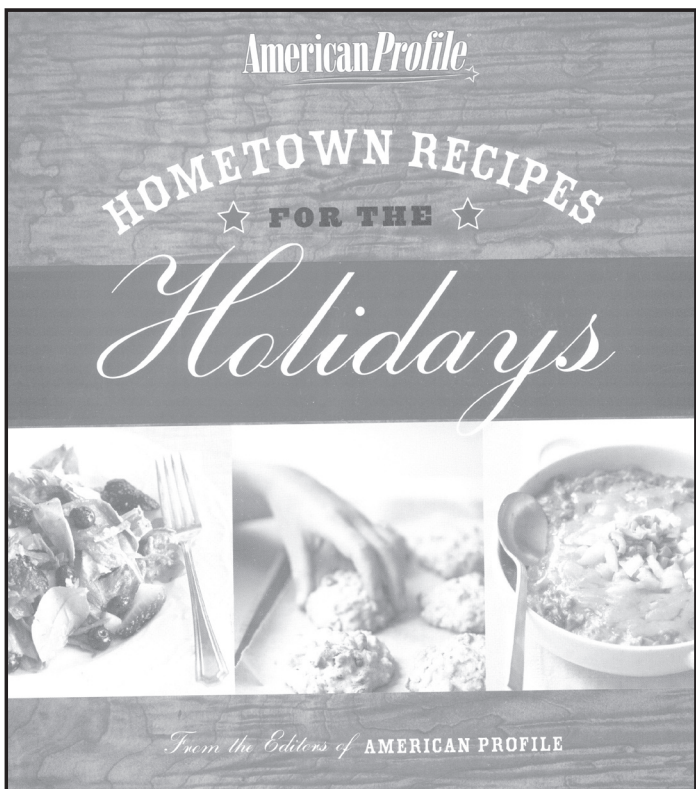

Thanksgiving Worship: Give to the Lord

Enjoying thanksgiving to God includes giving to Him. It has often been said, "Thanksgiving is both 'Thanks' and 'Giving.'"

Holy Spirit illuminated Christians desire to overcome the world's view on how to celebrate Thanksgiving Day. Thus, they look to the whole counsel of God's Word because there are various Scriptures referring to national feasts unto the Lord which present truths and principles that have eternal obligations.

The Word of God teaches about three feasts that all present truths that must be understood if a person is going to fully enjoy what the Lord has for them this Thanksgiving Season. One of the feasts the men of God were required to attend and the rest of the family and servants were certainly encouraged to participate in was "The Feast of Weeks." Deuteronomy 16:10 gives the people of God this exhortation, "Then celebrate the Feast of Weeks to the LORD your God by giving a freewill offering in proportion to the blessings the LORD your God has given you." This feast is also referred to as the "Feast of Harvest." It was to be celebrated in times of harvest and it was to be a joyous celebration.

In truth "Thanksgiving Day" in America was meant to be a religious celebration. In fact the Pilgrims called this harvest festival, "A Thanksgiving" (Pilgrim Hall Museum, America's Museum of Pilgrim Possessions) and scholarly researchers say it was celebrated in the fall time of the year. Society for the Confluence of Festivals writes this about the first Thanksgiving at Plymouth, "The Pilgrims organized the feast right after the first harvest. It was a gesture to thank God..."

Christians who are the most influential for the Lord's work are those who humbly give public praise to God and they express their praise through giving to the Lord's work or giving to the needy in the Name of Jesus Christ. Christians see the Thanksgiving Season as an opportunity to give in a way that expresses a life that says, "all the blessings we enjoy come from the Lord, therefore, we give joyfully from the harvest He has given."
