

FOUND IN THE HEART OF OBEDIENCE

The Biblical account of the life of Joseph holds truths that the Holy Spirit of Christ wants you to grasp this Christmas season. Matthew chapter one says, Joseph... was a righteous man." "... the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream," "When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. This is a great encouragement to all Christians. Most Christians are not going to be famous, have a place of authority nor be rich in the world's eyes. They can, however, become very important in proclaiming the good news of the gospel of Christ as long as they are willing to seek the will of the Lord through the written Word of God and obey what the Holy Spirit of Christ calls them to do.
