A reverent fear keeps the spiritual heart from the bondage of false religion and enables Christians to minister to the Christ who died for them. True Christianity strives to meet the needs of the needy, doing so as though doing unto Christ. Jesus taught, "...Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited Me in, I needed clothes and you clothed Me, I was sick and you looked after Me, I was in prison and you came to visit Me.' Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You something to drink? When did we see You a stranger and invite You in, or needing clothes and clothe You? When did we see You sick or in prison and go to visit You?"" (Matthew 25:34-40)

The Bible records Jesus saying, "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for Me." (Matthew 25:41)

This powerful teaching of Jesus Christ refers to the time when He will come at the finial Judgment, when He will be dealing with all of mankind. This is an individual judgment and it is imperative that you understand this is not a teaching of good works to Christ Jesus so you can be saved. It is a reflection of good works produced from those who love Jesus Christ.

Christians remain steadfast in what God has called them to do when they see every stranger as an opportunity to do good in reaching that person for Christ.
