



Christians expressing true love are active in a ministry that is pleasing to the Lord and they look for people to serve. Galatians 6:10 says, "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers." Hebrews 13:16 says, "...do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased." Jesus said, "But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because He is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." (Luke 6:35-36)

The little girl said, 'I will not have many chances to serve the Lord while I am small. But [by His grace] I will use the one-cat power I have, and serve Him all I can."

Let the Holy Spirit put this truth deep within your spiritual heart. You are to do good to all as the Lord makes the way, simply because God's Word tells you to. Holy Spirit Illuminated Christians exercise true religion through agape love.


