

Huskies end season with loss to Victoria

The Northern Valley boys Husky basketball team ended their season with a 51-17 loss to Victoria in the Regional tournament last Monday, February 22.

The first quarter was scoreless for the Huskies.

Victoria scored a total of five points which ended the quarter 5-0.

In the second quarter, the Huskies were only able to score two points made by Austin Herman. Victoria out-shot and out-paid the Huskies. The half-time score stood at 23-2.

In the third quarter, the Northern Valley team rallied.

Dusty Eagleburger sank three two-pointers and Colton Lowry made two two-pointers and sank one of two free throws. Eleven points was a nice come back from the first two quarters but not enough since Victoria once again

scored 18 points in the quarter.

The score at the end of the third quarter was 41-13.

The Huskies lost their steam in the fourth and final quarter. Phillip Compton and Brandon Towery each scored two points.

It was not nearly enough to take the lead and win the game.

It was another good quarter for Victoria who scored 10 more points for the victory.

Coach Chuck Fessenden said, "We played our worst half of the season. We had no movement on offense. Things improved in the third quarter, however it was way too late."

The leading scorer for the Huskies was Dusty Eagleburger with 6 points, followed by Colton Lowry, 5; and Austin Herman, Phillip Compton and Brandon Towery with 2 each.

This ended the Northern Valley boys basketball season for 2009-2010.

Next, he won a 4-1 decision over Colton Gentry, Rossville, to reach the championship finals versus Nick Thibault, Halstead.

Spencer trailed 9-1 after one period and 10-3 after two and was pinned in 4:30 by Thibault, who had only lost one match this season.

Daniel Jordan, Oberlin, placed third with a 3-1 decision over Gentry. Colton Johnson, Marion, placed fifth with a 7-2 decision over Matt Menear, Council Grove.

Shirk finished the season 33-3 and Thibault completed a 35-1 season record. Jordan was 30-10 for the season and Gentry was 42-7.

It was a rematch of the regional championship where Kaid won 9-7 with a takedown in overtime. It was another hard fought match with no score after one period but Werth edged Kaid 5-3 to place third.

Omlie won the championship with a 5-3 decision over Brett Dunlap, Doniphan West. Colt Castlebury, Douglass, won fifth with a 4-3 decision over Long.

McKenna finished the season with a 36-9 record. Omlie finished an unbeaten 34-0 season. Dunlap

was 36-7, Werth, 32-5 and Castlebury 26-6.

Ethan Jirak, Oakley, completed an unbeaten season when he pinned Sione John Siale, Chaparral, in 3:58. Third place went to Martinez with a 5-2 decision over Thomas Lowe, Eureka. Dustin Bayless, Caney Valley, placed fifth by pinning Tanner Taylor.

in the championship semi-finals but came back to place third by pinning Jay Cotter, Goodland, in 2:49. Clay Wilcox, Chaparral, finished in fifth with a 5-1 decision over Dakota Denny, Caney Valley.

Salmans finished the season with a 38-2 record, Huffman was 33-3, Rice 36-2 and Cotter 28-7.

Rice was the defending state champion.

He pinned Huffman for the title last year when Salmans placed third.
