You are required to file your written defenses thereto on or before May

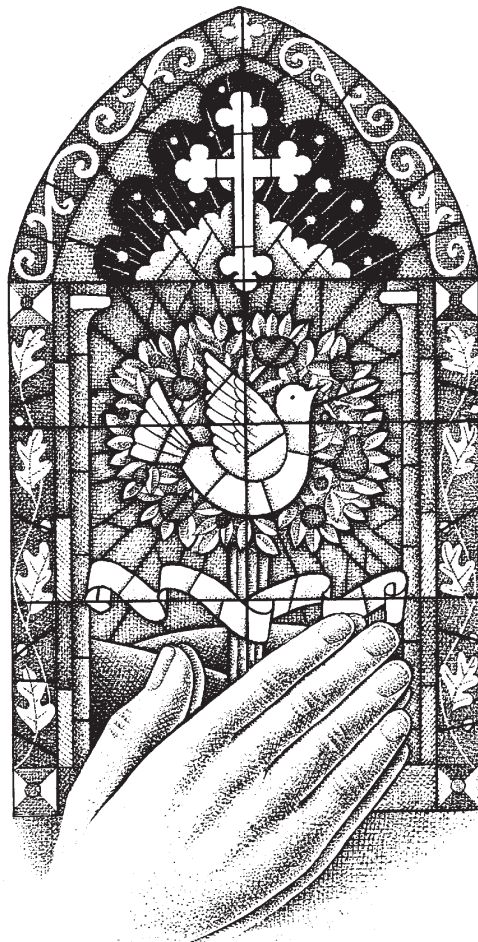
