 lege, and the only cowgirl on the crew, immediately administered three injections into the neck of each calf. Roger Wilson sprayed it with a long-lasting insecticide while another cowboy placed a

red-hot branding iron on the calf for about two seconds. Another tagged its ear, still another gave it one more injection; and if it was a bull calf, it was castrated.  
 All this took place in the span of less than two minutes. The

calves were then sorted into pens as the next two were brought in for their turn.  
 Others helping with the roundup and branding included Matt Wilson, Keith Mannie, Walt Marble, Kyle Edgett, Lance Braun and

16-month-old Dali Braun.  
 "All in all, it was a good day," Mr. Wilson said. "We got done about 7:30, and nobody got hurt. "Everybody worked pretty hard. Some of us had fun and some of us were just plain tired."


