

Fishing report

Black bass - Fair — The density rating for Sebelyus largemouth bass, 12 inches and above, is fifth among all reservoirs in the state.

Good number of spotted bass are also present, with a density rating of second in reservoirs in the state.

Spinner and artificial bait should work well in Leota Cove, along the dam, Schoen's

Cove and by the river sandpit. A 15 inch length limit on largemouth and spotted bass is in effect.

Catfish - Fair to Good — The supply of channel catfish is good with 11 to 15 inch fish being plentiful. Flathead numbers are also on the rise.

These fish can be caught off the feeder around Leota Cove,

north of the dam, west of the Marsh Dike and around the sandpit.

Shad sides, gizzards, night crawlers, stink bait or shrimp is the best bait.

Black and White Crappie - Fair to Good — White crappie numbers increased from last year and black crappie numbers have almost tripled.

The density rating for Sebelyus Crappie is second in the state. These fish can be found around the Marina, public fishing dock or in the coves. Jigs or jigs topped with a minnow are the best bait.

Saugeye - Good — The Saugeye population is at 59 percent; catch rates will be good.

The density rating is first among all reservoirs in the state. An 18 inch length limit is in effect.

Walleye - Fair — These fish will move to the flats in May. Jigs, crank baits and night crawlers are the best bait. There is an 18 inch limit in effect.

Wipers - Good — The sup-

ply is strong, with larger fish being available as well as fish in the 15 to 30 inch range. The density rating for this fish is sixth. Bucktail jigs cast along the north shore have been effective.

Nigh crawlers and shrimp on the bottom of Leota Cove and using live bait off the drop offs outside of Leota and Concrete Coves has been effective.

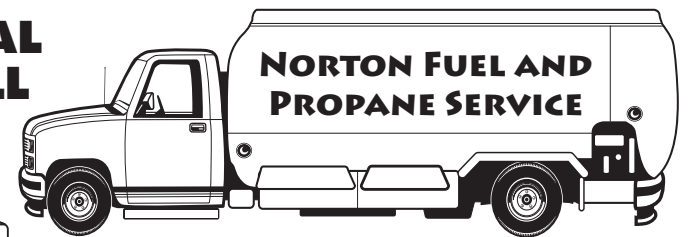
