The home-owned carnival will be in full-swing starting at 6:30 p.m. and the Ranch Rodeo will begin at sharply 7 p.m.

The 4-H clubs of Norton County invite your family to join others at the 4-H Porkburger Special.

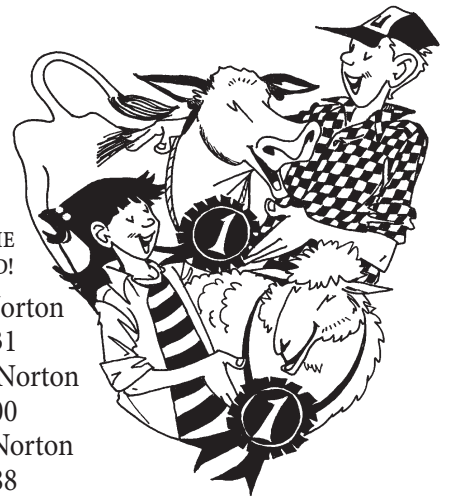

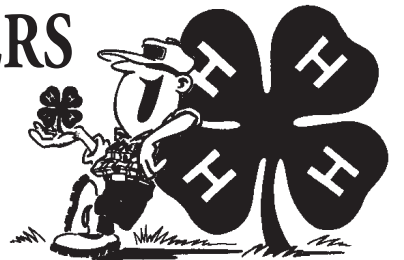
