ORDINANCE NO. 1602
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 1 OF THE NORTON CITY CODE RELATING TO MUNICIPAL COURT COSTS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS: **Section 1.** Section 9-105 of the Code of the City of Norton, Kansas, is hereby

amended to read as follows: 9-105. COURT COST FEE. In all cases filed in the Municipal Court of Norton,

Kansas, where there is a finding of guilty or a plea of guilty, a plea of no contest, forfeiture of a bond, or a diversion, there shall be assessed a cost as provided below. The costs shall be for the administration of justice in the Municipal Court. That the City shall remit to the State Treasurer those amounts required for state required municipal court cost funding. The court costs shall be as follows:

For the purposes of determining the amount to be assessed, if more than one complaint is filled against one individual arising out of the same incident, all such complaints shall be considered as one case.

In addition to the court costs and penalties, a person who fails to comply with

a traffic citation, except for illegal parking, standing or stopping, shall be mailed a notice that if such person does not appear in municipal court or pay all fines, court costs and penalties within thirty (30) days from the date of mailing notice, the division of vehicles will be notified to suspend the person's driving privileges. The municipal court shall charge a fee of \$5.00 for mailing such notice, which shall be assessed as costs. or pay all fines, court costs and penalties within thirty (30) days from the date of mailing notice, the division of vehicles will be notified to suspend the person's driving privileges. 
