# ORDINANCE NO. 262

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER RATES BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Norcatur, Kansas, Section 1. WATER RATES. Water consumers in the City of Norcatur shall pay for their use and consumption of water furnished or supplied by the city at the

for their use and consumption of water furnished or supplied by the city at the monthly rate of \$12.00 for the first 2000 gallons or any part thereof with all water delivered above 2000 gallons to be charged at the rate of \$2.50 per thousand gallons or any part thereof.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.



# "Effective Broadcasting"

## **Has Biblical Priorities**

The key step to effective broadcasting of God's Word is to have a Body of Christ that has Biblical priorities. The Holy Spirit led, anointed and empowered church birthed forth from Pentecost had men of God who knew their priorities. Acts 6:2 says, "So the twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, 'It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the Word of God in order to wait on tables." Our key text says, "But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the Word." (Acts 6:4)

These passages of Scripture came forth at a time when the New Testament church was growing and the people of God needed Divine instructions. God in His mercy and grace sent forth His Holy Spirit to give the Body of Christ administrative direction in regard to proclaiming the Word of God.

In order for the conviction of sin, the conversion of sinners, and the edification of the Body of Christ, there must be men and women of God who devote their time, strength, and gifting to the proclaiming and teaching of God's Word. No one is denying the importance of tongues, miracles, and supernatural healings. Many enjoy beautiful church buildings, wonderful services, spiritual programs and the benefits of a helps ministry. However, these are not enjoyed or empowered by the Holy Spirit of Christ unless there are those who employ themselves in the service of preaching and teaching the written Word of God undergirded with prayer. (Acts 6:1-7)

The word "devote" (*proskarteréō*) means to occupy oneself diligently, to pay persistent attention to, (Analytical Lexicon of the Greek Language) to persist, keep on with devotion, (Dictionary of Biblical Languages with Semantic Domains) or to give constant attention to. (Thayer's Greek-English Lexicon of the New Testament)

Every Holy Spirit illuminated church has Biblical Elders who take seriously 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."
