



# Has Spiritual Leaders

#### has Spiritual Leaders

2 Timothy 2:15 says, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

The true church has preachers and teachers who spend much time privately in prayerful study of the Word of God which is the sword of the Holy Spirit, (Ephesians 6:17) so they can be effective in the cause of Christ and God. The truth is, faithful prayerful students of God's Word become servants whom the Lord uses long after their physical death, just like the writings of those the Holy Spirit used to bring us the written Word of God.

One great man of God who the Lord and the Holy Spirit is still using even today is Matthew Henry, the man who laid the foundational work of the well known Matthew Henry Commentaries. He and the church he oversaw for the Lord were illuminated with the truth of being devoted to the preaching of God's Word. Dr. Daniel Williams said, "Matthew Henry learned from the early puritans and other non-conformists the joy of getting up early to spend time in the intense toil of prayerful study of God's Word."

Nothing caused Matthew Henry more uneasiness than needless intrusions. Whether those inroads upon time and strength arose out of mistaken politeness, or the influence of inconsiderate friendship, they invariably extorted self-reproach. lamentations and Matthew experienced the spiritual grieving that comes when the preacher of God's Word has been robbed of His time in getting prayerful revelation from the Bible. In his diary Matthew Henry wrote, "...I am always best when alone. No place like my own study, no company like that of good books, especially His Book [the Bible]."

Matthew Henry was willing to pay the cost to prepare to follow God's administration for the New Testament church. In the Encyclopedia Britannica, Eleventh Edition we read, "While millions of pastors have come and gone since the 1700's, most preachers' works have not achieved the respect and usefulness that the Matthew Henry Commentaries have accomplished even to this day."
