**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The City of Clayton will hold a public hearing on Monday, September 13, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Clayton Community Center (S. end of Oak Street), Clayton, Kansas, for the purpose of considering an application to be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Water/Sewer category. A specific project application to be discussed is water system improvements in an area generally bounded by the city limits of Clayton. Work will consist of the installation of centralized treatment equipment for the removal of arsenic, an emergency generator, appurtenant well and piping improvements, geotechnical review of the foundation for the existing standpipe for potential upgrades, the construction of a new foundation for the existing standpipe (if warranted), and protective coating upgrades for the standpipe.

The estimated project cost is \$500,000 with the grant request for \$140,000 of the project cost. The City has filed a pre-application with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, for financial assistance to complete this project. Other project proposals introduced at the hearing will be considered. Oral and written comments will be recorded and become a part of the City of Clayton's CDBG Citizen Participation Plan.

Reasonable accommodations will be made available to persons with disabilities. Requests should be submitted to Barbara Brooks, City Clerk by Friday, September 10, 2010.
