**NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK FUNDING**  
It is the intention of the City of Clayton, Kansas in Norton and Decatur County, Kansas to seek and apply for permanent funding from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development agency to rehabilitate its water mains, make improvements to its water storage equipment, and to develop a centralized plant to treat its drinking water supply in order to lower the level of arsenic in the supply to an acceptable level.  
The city has contracted with a licensed professional engineer to complete a preliminary engineering report. The study will examine options to rehabilitate the system, determine costs, and make a recommendation to the city council. As part of the application process, Rural Development will require the city to hold a public information meeting. At which the contents of the PER will be made public and allow patrons to gain information about any proposed plan. Additional funding sources may also be used for such a project as temporary funding for construction and/or for supplemental financing to any provided by USDA Rural Development.
