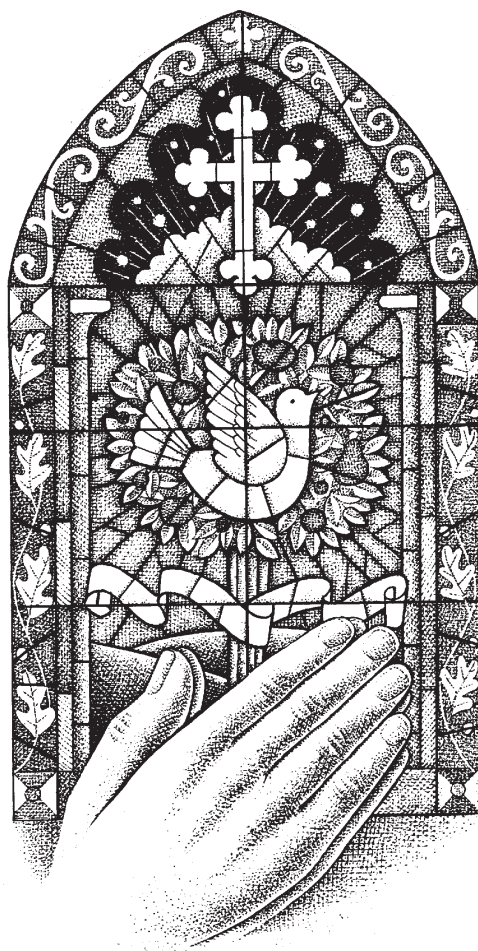

## Cross Roads "Effective Broadcasting"

### Fertilizer of Prayer

Christians who effectively plant the seeds of God's Word use the fertilizer of prayer. 2 Thessalonians 3:1 says, "Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you." 1 Corinthians 3:7 says, "So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. The man who plants and the man who waters have one purpose, and each will be rewarded according to his own labor. For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building."

Christians who are planting the Word of God out in the fields of the world have a heart desire to see the Word get out where people can read and/or hear it. Their prayer is that people receive a powerful hunger and thirst for the Word of God.

In these last days, Christians pray that opposition to the publication and public proclamation of the Word of God be removed. Romans 10:14-15 says, "How, then, can they call on the One they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the One of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent?"

To "Preach" (kerusso) means to publish or announce religious truths, the gospel with its attendant privileges and obligations, in this gospel dispensation. It is to proclaim publicly after the manner of a herald always with authority such as to beckon people to listen and obey what is proclaimed. Christians pray because they know the Bible says no one comes to Christ unless the Father draws him. (John 6:44)

One ministry of the Lord who grasps the truth of praying for their work in "The Great Commission" is the Billy Graham organization. They literally pray over every letter sent out, for every promotional ad, for everyone involved in a certain ministry outreach, they even hand out cards to Christians so they can write down names of people who they would like to see come to Christ. These cards are collected in special services and thousands have agreed together in prayer for the names of the people on those cards. This is why for so many years the Billy Graham association was so powerfully used of God around the world.
