## **Fertilizer of Prayer**

Christians who effectively plant the seeds of God's Word use the fertilizer of prayer. 2 Thessalonians 3:1 says, "Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you." Christians pray because they know the Bible says no one comes to Christ unless the Father draws him. (John 6:44)

They literally pray over every letter sent out, for every promotional ad, for everyone involved in a certain ministry outreach, they even hand out cards to Christians so they can write down names of people who they would like to see come to Christ. 
