# Deadline for disaster loans is approaching

The expiration date for filing applications for Emergency Disaster loans by farmers and ranchers in Decatur, Norton, and Phillips Counties is Nov. 26, according to John C. Vogt, Farm Loan Manager, for the Farm Service Agency.

Vogt advised that those needing farm credit as a result of severe winter storms and snowstorms from Dec. 22, 2009 to Jan. 8, 2010 and who think they are eligible for Farm Service Agency assistance, should make their applications at the Norton County Farm Service Agency Office, PO Box 365, 11506 Pineview Dr., Norton, KS 67654 before the expiration date.

"Loans covering physical losses may be made at 3.75 percent interest rate, and are scheduled for repayment as rapidly as feasible, consistent with the applicant's reasonable ability to pay," said Vogt.

Farm Service Agency's Farm Loan Programs staff is committed to new and existing customers, Farm Service Agency customer goals and our rural communities. Farm Service Agency's service extends beyond the typical loan, offering Farm Service Agency customers ongoing consultation,

Farm Service Agency loans covering physical losses may be used to replace installations, equipment, livestock, or buildings (including homes), lost through this disaster.

To be eligible for an emergency disaster loan, an applicant must be operating a family size farm or ranch, must be unable to get credit elsewhere, and must have suffered a qualifying physical loss from the disaster.

Farmers and ranchers that think they may be eligible should contact the Farm Service Agency County Office in Norton or call 785-877-5156 for additional information and how to apply.
