

ranking period cut-off date for producer applications in Natural Resources Conservation Service' Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) has been extended to January 7, 2011.

"We're extending the deadline for applications to provide agricultural producers more time to complete their applications," said White.

"With the additional time, farmers can use this program's selfscreening checklist to determine if the program is suitable for their operation and then go to their Natural Resources Conservation Service office and sign-up." said Eric B. Banks, Natural Resources Conservation Service State Conservationist in Kansas.

The Conservation Stewardship Program checklist highlights basic information about eligibility requirements, contract obligations, and potential payments. It is available from local Natural Resources Conservation Service offices or online.
