You are hereby notified that a petition has been filed in this court alleging that the child named above is a Child in Need of Care. The court may find that the parents are unfit by reason or conduct or condition which renders the parents unable to care properly for a child, the conduct or condition is unlikely to change in the foreseeable future, the parental rights of the parent should be terminated, and a permanent guardian should be appointed for the child.(ren).

A hearing on the petition is scheduled for the 7th day of December, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. At the hearing the Court may issue orders relating to the care, custody and control of the child. “Gratitude Should Be Expansive!”

The Holy Spirit of Christ moved the Apostle Paul to write, "...give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thessalonians 5:16-17)

The two words "all circumstances" make this exhortation from the Lord very difficult. If we were told in most things or in good things, we would find it much easier to accept and obey.

The Apostle Paul lived what he preached and this is so clearly seen in Acts 16:16-43. Paul and Silas were thrown into prison and put into stocks. Jesus even taught that physical infirmities can be an attack from Satan (Luke 13:11-16). We are to follow the Biblical example of those who praise the Lord, regardless of their circumstances.

Our expansive praises are heard by others. Expansive praise birthed from a sure trust in the Sovereignty of God proves there is something different about Christians in comparison to those who live in this world.

For application's sake: Do people around you know that regardless of your circumstances, good or bad, you live a life of praise to God?
