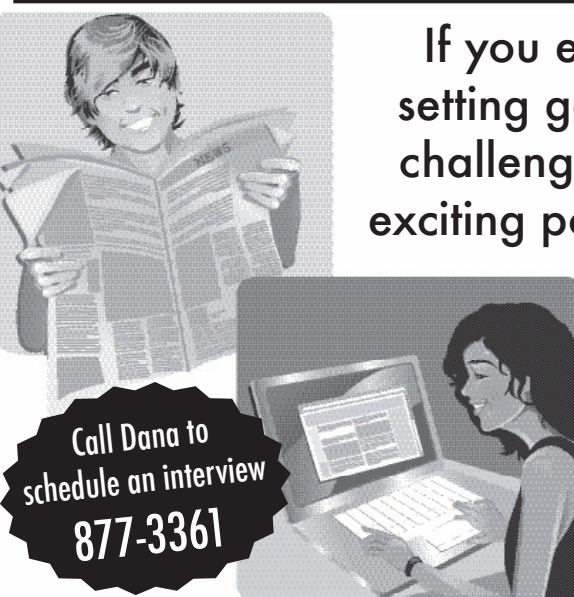

Wells dba Pioneer Resources has filed an application to commence the injection of salt water into the Cedar Hills formation (approximately 1308' to 1505') at the Baird #1, located in the NE, NW, SW, SW/4 of 24-05S-21W (1289' FSL and 342' FWL), Norton County, Kansas. The proposed injection rate will be approximately 500 bbl/day at 0 psig. Any persons who object to or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protests with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within fifteen (15) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the state of Kansas.
