A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT THE STRUCTURES LOCATED AT LOT SIX, BLOCK FOURTEEN AND THE WEST HALF OF THE VACATED STREET ADJACENT ON THE EAST, GOLF ADDITION IN THE CITY OF NORTON, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS COMMONLY KNOWN AS 207 E WOODSFIELD, NORTON, KANSAS, IS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS AND DIRECTING THAT THE STRUCTURE BE REMOVED AND THE PREMISES MADE SAFE AND SECURE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

**Section 1:** That the enforcing officer of the City of Norton, Kansas, did on the 11th day of October, 2010, file with the governing body of the City a statement in writing that a certain structure, hereinafter described, was unsafe and dangerous.

**Section 2:** That the Governing Body did by Resolution No. 13-2010 dated the 20th day of October, 2010, fix the time and place of a hearing at which the owner, his or her agent, and lienholders, any occupants and all other parties of interest of such structure could appear and show cause why such structure should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished, and provided for giving notice thereof as provided by law.

**Section 3:** That Resolution No. 13-2010 was published in the official city newspaper on the 22nd day of October, 2010, and on the 29th day of October, 2010 and a copy of said resolution was served upon all persons entitled thereto as provided by law.

**Section 4:** That on the 1st day of December, 2010, the governing body did conduct the hearing as scheduled and took evidence from the following: the enforcing officer on behalf of the City, Jeff Wolf. The following parties in interest appeared and presented evidence: Mark Sainz, Elizabeth Sainz and Wanda Daniels.

**Section 5:** That the governing body hereby finds that the structure located at:

LOT SIX, BLOCK FOURTEEN AND THE WEST HALF OF THE VACATED STREET ADJACENT ON THE EAST, GOLF ADDITION IN THE CITY OF NORTON, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS COMMONLY KNOWN AS 207 E WOODSFIELD, NORTON, KANSAS

is unsafe and dangerous and the City directs that such structure be removed and the premises be made safe and secure.

**Section 6:** That the owners of such structure are hereby directed to commence the removal of the property within thirty days from the date of publication of this resolution and to have the removal completed within sixty days of the commencement. Provided, that upon due application by the owner and for good cause shown, the governing body, in its sole discretion, may grant the owner additional time to complete the removal of the property.

**Section 7:** That if the owner fails to commence the removal of the structures within the time stated herein, or any additional time granted by the governing body, or fails to diligently prosecute the same until the work is completed, the governing body will cause the structure to be razed and removed and the costs of razing and removing, less salvage if any, shall be collected in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1-1115 and amendments thereto, or shall be assessed as a special assessment against the lot or parcel of land upon which the structure is located or by both, all as provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the owner fails to commence the removal of the structure within the time provided herein or fails to diligently prosecute the same, the governing body may take such further action as it deems necessary to raze and remove the structure without further notice to the owner or other parties in interest.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published once in the official city newspaper and mail a copy to the owners, agents, lienholders, occupants and other parties in interest.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the governing body of the City of Norton, Kansas on this 1st day of December, 2010.
