Section 4: That on the 1st day of December, 2010, the governing body did conduct the hearing as scheduled and took evidence from the following: the enforcing officer on behalf of the City, Jeff Wolf. The following parties in interest appeared and

presented evidence: Mark Saintz, Elizabeth Saintz and Wanda Daniels Section 5: That the governing body hereby finds that the structure located at:

LOT SIX, BLOCK FOURTEEN AND THE WEST HALF OF THE VACATED STREET ADJACENT ON THE EAST, GOLF ADDITION IN THE CITY OF NORTON, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS COMMONLY KNOWN AS 207 E

WOODSFIELD, NORTON, KANSAS is unsafe and dangerous and the City directs that such structure be removed and

Section 6: That the owners of such structure are hereby directed to commence the removal of the property within thirty days from the date of publication of this resolution and to have the removal completed within sixty days of the commencement. Provided, that upon due application by the owner and for good cause shown, the governing body, in its sole discretion, may grant the owner additional time to complete the removal of the property.

Section 7: That if the owner fails to commence the removal of the structures within the time stated herein, or any additional time granted by the governing body, or fails to diligently prosecute the same until the work is completed, the governing body will cause the structure to be razed and removed and the costs of razing and removing, less salvage if any, shall be collected in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1,1115 and amendments thereto, or shall be assessed as a special assessment against the lot or parcel of land upon which the structure is located or by both, all as provided by law.


