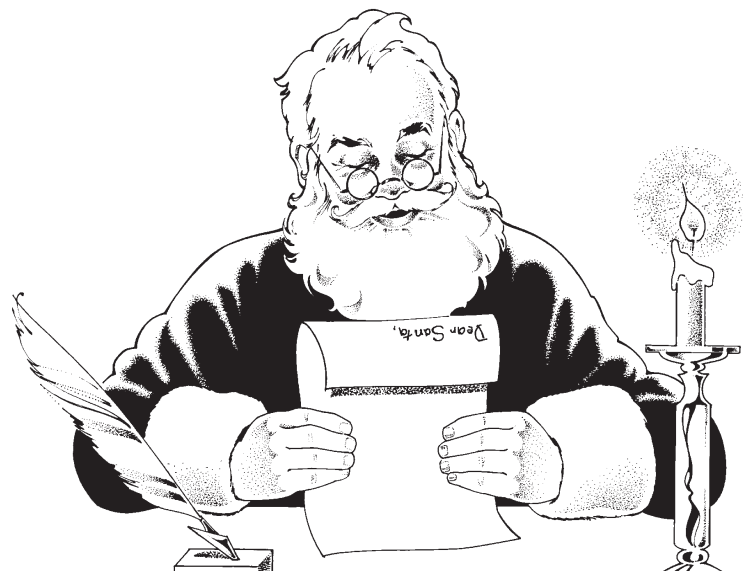


Letters To Santa
