Norton outscored opponents 443 points to 137 points for an average win of 44.3-13.7.

They rolled up 3,162 rushing average. yards on 385 attempts for an average of 8.21 yards per carry! The Blue Jays also passed for 1,009 yards on a 55 percent completion rate for 4,171 total yards rushing and passing.

Leading rusher for Norton was senior tailback Terrell Lane who gained 1,766 yards on 148 carries for a fantastic average of 11.93 yards per carry!
