A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next electon, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes 14 days

When a registered voter changes residence from one precinct to another precinct, such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the county election officer to be registered. Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer upon request by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.

When a registered voter fails to vote in two consecutive general elections, such voter's name may be removed from the registration books and party affiliation lists. Such voter must reregister in order to be eligible to vote. In Witness Whereof I have here unto
