Only two points were scored by the Huskies in the first quarter. Colton Lowry hit the basket. Franklin put nine points on the board with Sindt sinking a three pointer followed by Bartels Siel and Hemck each making two to end the quarter 9-2.

In the second quarter, Austin Herman was the lone scorer for Northern Valley hitting a two pointer and then making three of

four free throws followed up with another two pointer. Franklin once again outscored the Huskies with Vetter getting a two and a three point basket followed by Hammer, Sindt and Siel each adding two to the tally ending the first half in the lead, 20-9.

During the third quarter, Dusty Eagleburger was the only Husky to score hitting one three point shot. Franklin put ten more on the board. Siel with a two pointer and two of four free throws followed by Sindt with two, 2 pointers and Hemck with another two. The Huskies now trailed 30-12.

In the final quarter of the game, Northern Valley regained composure and Jordan Baird and Alex Tharman each got a three pointer followed by Daniel Field, Bryant Tharman and Gunnar Hays each getting two and Phillip Compton getting another point for a total of 13. Franklin didn't slow down and continued scoring. Sindt with two, 2 pointers and two free throws followed by Siel and Hammer with four points each and Lennemann with one free throw to win the game 45-25.

Northern Valley head coach Chuck Fessenden said, "Once

again we played well enough to the defensive end to give ourselves a chance to win. However, we struggled on the offensive end of the floor. We shot only 17% from the two point range. We did go three out of six from the three point line but two of those came late from our JV players."

The leading rebounder was Tyler Montgomery with 7.

In junior varsity play against Franklin the Huskies lost 36-28. The leading scorer for the game was Jordan Baird with 9. Leading rebounders were Phillip Compton and Daniel Field with 6 each.

The first quarter started off pretty good for the Huskies. 


