The heart that understands what Jesus accomplished on the first Easter births forth a "Life Filled with Meaning," and "Life Freed by Grace."

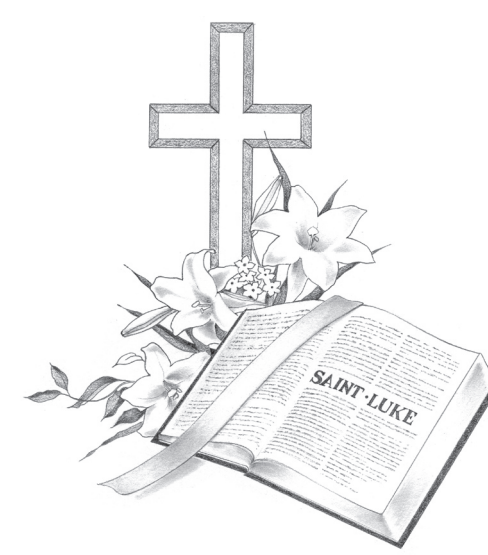
