In all of 2010 the poison control center had 2,874 calls about this drug. So far this year, there have been 1,300 calls. These numbers prove that there has been a great increase in usage. At least 20 states have banned chemical found in fake marijuana. Most other states have legislation pending.

Bath Salts are also synthetic compounds that contain two every day. Kansas has already powerful stimulants: methylenedioxpyrovalerone or MDPV and mephedrone, which mimic cocaine, LSD and methamphetamines. Side effects vary but are similar to those of cocaine and methamphetamines and the adverse effects can be as bad or

One doctor in Salina reported that nearly 100 percent of the patients he had treated that had used Bath Salts experienced extreme Rich Wenzl said, "Parents need suicidal thoughts while coming off the high from the drug. Also, people taking this drug, when they show up in the emergency rooms, many times are extremely violent. Most hospitals are not staffed with security personnel to deal with these violent patients.

Bath Salts is usually found in powder form. It comes packaged in plastic bags or in containers resembling hand or face cream with the words Bath Salts, Purple Wave or Bliss on them. They are smoked, injected, inhaled or even eaten.

The calls to the poison control center due to the use of Bath Salts is increasing at a greater rate. In 2010 a total of 301 calls were
