smoke it.

In all of 2010 the poison control center had 2,874 calls about this drug. So far this year, there have been 1,300 calls. These numbers prove that there has been a great increase in usage. At least 20 states have banned chemical found in fake marijuana. Most other states have legislation pending.

Bath Salts are also synthetic compounds that contain two powerful stimulants: methyl-enedioxyvalerone or MDPV and mephedrone, which mimic cocaine, LSD and methamphetamine. Side effects vary but are similar to those of cocaine and methamphetamines and the adverse effects can be as bad or worse.

One doctor in Salina reported that nearly 100 percent of the patients he had treated that had used Bath Salts experienced extreme suicidal thoughts while coming off the high from the drug. Also, people taking this drug, when they show up in the emergency rooms, many times are extremely violent. Most hospitals are not staffed with security personnel to deal with these violent patients.


Bath Salts is usually found in powder form. It comes packaged in plastic bags or in containers resembling hand or face cream with the words Bath Salts, Purple Wave or Bliss on them. They are smoked, injected, inhaled or even eaten.

The calls to the poison control center due to the use of Bath Salts is increasing at a greater rate. In 2010 a total of 301 calls were

taken. In the first three months of 2011, 1,400 calls have been made. Most of the calls come from doctors and nurses from emergency rooms. At least nine states have banned substances found in Bath Salts, and 25 have laws in the works.

Both these synthetic drugs are being marketed as safe and better than what has come before. They are not. They are killing kids across the United States nearly every day. Kansas has already seen a significant increase in the use of these drugs. K-2 is in Salina, it is in Hays, and there has already been one suspected case in Norton. There have been no medical studies done yet on these drugs to see what the long term effects will be on humans, but the short term consequences appear to be as bad if not worse than other drugs out there.

Norton County Undersheriff, Rich Wenzl said, “Parents need to know how devastating these drugs are.”
