ORDINANCE NO. 263

AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORCATUR, KANSAS, DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO IMPROVE, EQUIP AND REHABILITATE THE EXISTING WATER WELLS AND INSTALL A NEW WATER MAIN IN THE CITY; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INSTALLING, IMPROVING, EQUIPPING AND REHABILITATION OF SAID SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS THEREOF; AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION IMPROVEMENT BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE PROJECT COSTS; AND DECLARING IT NECESSARY AND ADVISABLE TO PROVIDE FOR THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF REDEMPTION OF THE CITY'S GENERAL OBLIGATION WATER IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 1999.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Norcatour, Kansas (the "City") is authorized under the laws of the State of Kansas, to own, operate and maintain a municipal water system and the City has previously acquired, constructed and maintains such a municipal water system (the "Water System"); and

WHEREAS, said Water System constitutes a "public water supply system" within the meaning of K.S.A. 65-162a and the governing body of said city hereby finds and determines it necessary and advisable to acquire and construct certain improvements to, and otherwise reconstruct improve, equip and rehabilitate the Water System, including particularly the improvement, equipping and rehabilitation of the existing water wells and installing a new 4" water main, together with all necessary appurtenances therefor and thereto (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the city is authorized by K.S.A. 65-162a et seq., as amended and supplemented and K.S.A. 10-101 et seq., as amended and supplemented (collectively the "Act"), to acquire, construct and install the Project; and to issue the City's general obligation bonds for the purpose of paying all or part of any costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously issued its General Obligation Water Improvement Bonds, Series 1999 dated January 1, 1999 in the original principal amount of \$105,000 of which \$40,000.00 remain outstanding (the "1999 Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, in order to achieve interest cost savings and to accomplish a comprehensive and orderly plan of financing. It is necessary and desirable to provide for the refunding and redemption of the outstanding 1999 Bonds in advance of their scheduled maturity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORCATUR, KANSAS:

Section 1. The Project is authorized and directed to be completed pursuant to the Act in accordance with certain estimates, plans and specifications before the governing body on this date.

Section 2. It is hereby authorized, ordered and directed that the Project be acquired, constructed and installed, all as hereinbefore described, at a total estimated cost of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), which estimate includes all fees and expenses of financing the Project.

Section 3. It is hereby further authorized, ordered and directed that the costs of acquiring, constructing and installing the Project shall be paid from the proceeds of the City's general obligation bonds to be issued by the City in an amount which shall not exceed \$200,000.

Section 4. The obligations authorized by this Ordinance are authorized to reimburse expenditures made by the City 60 days before the date of this Ordinance and thereafter, as provided in United States Treasury Regulation - 1.150-2.

Section 5. The City hereby indicates its intent to redeem and refund the outstanding 1999 Bonds on October 1, 2011. The city's intent is conditioned upon the issuance of the City's general obligation refunding and improvement bonds on or before the dates indicated.

Section 6. The Mayor, City Clerk and any Deputy City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to provide notice of the City's intent to redeem and to take all such other actions as may be appropriate or desirable to accomplish the purposes contemplated by this Ordinance, including but not limited to, providing any necessary notice of the City's intent to redeem the outstanding 1999 Bonds.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval, and its publication one time in the official newspaper of the City.

PASSED, ADOPTED AND APPROVED by the governing body of the City of Norcatour, Kansas on August 1, 2011.
