ORDINANCE NUMBER 1613 AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO URINATE OR DEFECCATE IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: Chapter 11, Article 2 of the Code of the City of Norton is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-204. Urinating, defecating in public unlawful. No person shall urinate or defecate in or upon any place open to the public or exposed to the public view, including the street, sidewalks, alleys, plazas, parks, parking lots, private property, and public buildings located within the city. This section shall not apply to urination or defecation utilizing fixtures in any public or private restroom or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste. Upon conviction of violation of this section, the defendant shall be fined or imprisoned, or both, pursuant to the general penalty provision in Section 1-702.

Section 2: This ordinance becomes effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1617 AN ORDINANCE ATTESTING TO AN INCREASE IN TAX REVENUES FOR BUDGET YEAR 2012 FOR THE CITY OF NORTON.

WHEREAS, the City of Norton must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this community; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of this city continues to increase.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Norton:

Section One. In accordance with state law, the City of Norton has scheduled a public hearing and has prepared the proposed budget necessary to fund city services from January 1, 2012 until December 31, 2012.

Section Two. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount exceeding the levy in the 2011 budget.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper.

Passed and approved by the Governing Body on this 3rd day of August, 2011.
