

Church honored for members' commitment to stewardship

ST. LOUIS, MO. (Nov. 30, 2011) – CFS (Capital Funding Services), a ministry of the Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF), honored Immanuel Lutheran Church of Norton, Kan., with its prestigious Antioch Reflection Award. Presented Nov. 18 in Raleigh, N.C., during LCEF's annual leadership conference, members Roger and Deanna Braun accepted the award on behalf of the congregation.

The congregation of Immanuel built a new worship center to double the space and provide accessible facilities for visitors and members. The extra space was needed because the congregation has been steadily adding members with a thriving mid-week Bible study program, and well-attended Sunday school classes and confirmation program. The new building, on land to accommodate further expansion, is a nod to the congregation's plans to continue to grow and, through the Holy Spirit, bring more people into the kingdom. Pastor Rev. Rick Rostek said the new church brought the congregation together and members were ready for this phase of growth.

CFS consultant Mark Marshall said that to help reduce the debt on the new facility, members committed \$500,000, exceeding their pledge goal of \$370,000.

"It was exciting to see God's work through our campaign as He raised up the members of Immanuel to do great things for Him in their rural setting," Marshall said.

Since 1992, CFS has worked with more than 700 congregations and agencies, helping members commit more than \$365 million for stewardship and to realize the visions that God has entrusted to them. 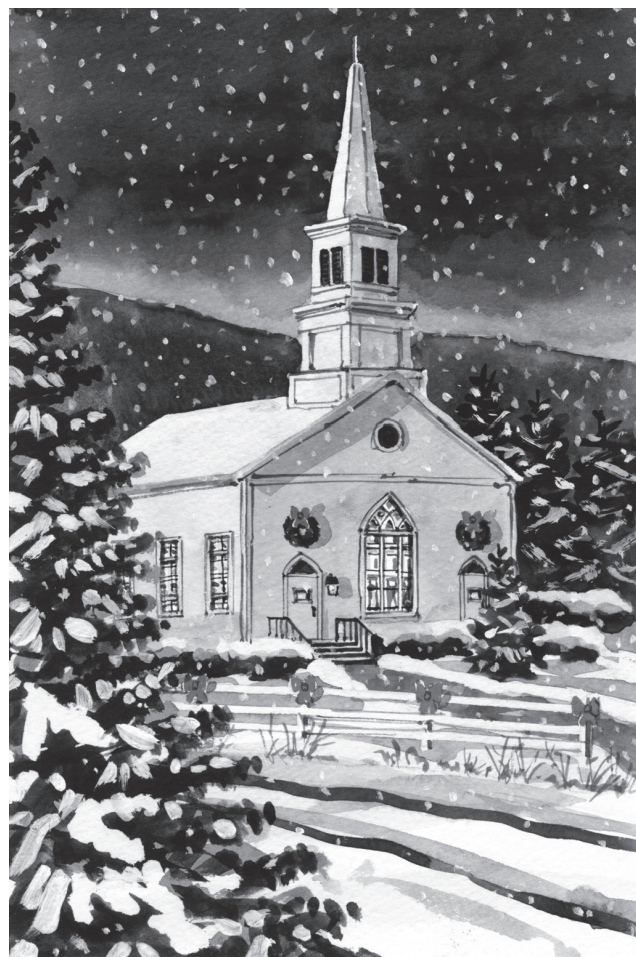
