#### RESOLUTION NO. 2012-03

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,000,000 TO PROVIDE FOR THE FINANCING OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS IN THE COUNTY, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE OF SUCH INTENTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of Norton County, Kansas (the "County") is authorized by K.S.A. 68-1103 (the "Act") to provide for the construction, repair or reconstruction for any road, bridge or culvert within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to provide for the paving and improvement of County Road E1 & L, including, but not limited to the acquisition of necessary right-of-way, easements and all other things necessary and appurtenant thereto (the "Road Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of the Road Project is \$3,000,000, and the County has determined it necessary to finance all or a portion of such costs through the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or temporary notes of the County under the authority of the Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The governing body of the County hereby determines that it is necessary to provide for the construction of the Road Project and states its intention to issue general obligation bonds of the County in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 to provide for the financing of all or a portion of the Road Project in accordance with the Act.

**SECTION 2.** Before issuing any such general obligation bonds of the County to pay costs of the Road Project, this resolution shall be published in the official County newspaper, once a week for three consecutive weeks and, if within 60 days following the last publication of such notice, a petition in opposition to the issuance of such bonds, signed by not less than 5% of the qualified electors of the County, is filed with the County election officer (County Clerk), no such bonds shall be issued unless a majority of the electors of the County voting on the question of such bonds shall approve the same at an election called and held in the manner provided for by law. If no sufficient petition is filed within the time period stated above, the County, acting through its board of county commissioners, shall proceed to issue such general obligation bonds and/or temporary notes to pay the costs of all or a portion of the Road Project.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution shall constitute a declaration of official intent for purposes of United States Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.

**SECTION 4.** It is hereby further authorized, ordered and directed that in order to temporarily finance the estimated costs of the Road Project until the issuance of the Bonds as hereinbefore provided, there may be issued temporary improvement notes (the "Notes"), such Notes to be issued from time to time upon subsequent resolution or resolutions of the County which shall provide and set forth the details of the Notes, including the fixing of the dates, terms, denominations, interest rates and maturity dates. Such Notes may be issued and provision may be made therefor as funds are needed and required for the orderly acquisition of the Road Project; and the Chairman and County Clerk are hereby authorized, ordered and directed to prepare and execute each of such Notes in accordance with the terms of this Resolution and the terms of the subsequent resolution or resolutions providing for same; and shall deliver the Notes to persons having claims against the County in connection with the Road Project, or may sell the Notes at private or public sale and apply the proceeds therefrom to the payment of the actual costs and expenses of the Project. Any Notes issued under the authority of this Section shall be issued under and will contain a recital that they are issued under the authority of the Act, and shall contain all other usual and required recitals and covenants and be in the form required therefor by said K.S.A. 10-123; and said Notes may be issued in combinations with any other temporary notes being issued by the County as shall be determined by the governing body at the time of such issuance to be in the County's best interest.

**SECTION 5.** The County Clerk is hereby directed and authorized to provide for the publication of this resolution in the manner described in Section 2 hereof.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 2012-04

**A RESOLUTION REGULATING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON COUNTY ROAD "L" LYING BETWEEN COUNTY ROAD E-1 AND COUNTY ROAD E-2 WITHIN NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

**WHEREAS**, Kansas law grants Norton County, Kansas, jurisdiction as a local authority to regulate the operation of motor vehicles upon roadways within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the ANTICIPATED INCREASE of highway traffic on County Road "L" within the County has caused the County of Norton, Kansas, to take steps to accommodate and regulate vehicular traffic on County Road "L" lying between County Road E-1 AND County Road E-2 in Norton County, Kansas.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** That the County road made subject of this resolution is described as follows:  
County Road "L" lying between County Road E-1 and County Road E-2 in Norton County, Kansas.

**SECTION TWO:** That traffic control devices shall be posted indicating that the maximum vehicle speed shall be 30 miles per hour upon the County road described in Section One of this resolution.

**SECTION THREE:** That it shall be unlawful for a person to drive a vehicle at a speed greater than the maximum lawful speed limit provided in Section Two of this resolution.

**SECTION FOUR:** That enforcement of this resolution and punishments for its violation shall be governed by the Kansas Uniform Act regulating traffic, K.S.A. 8-1401, et seq.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution take effect upon its adoption and publication in the official County newspaper.

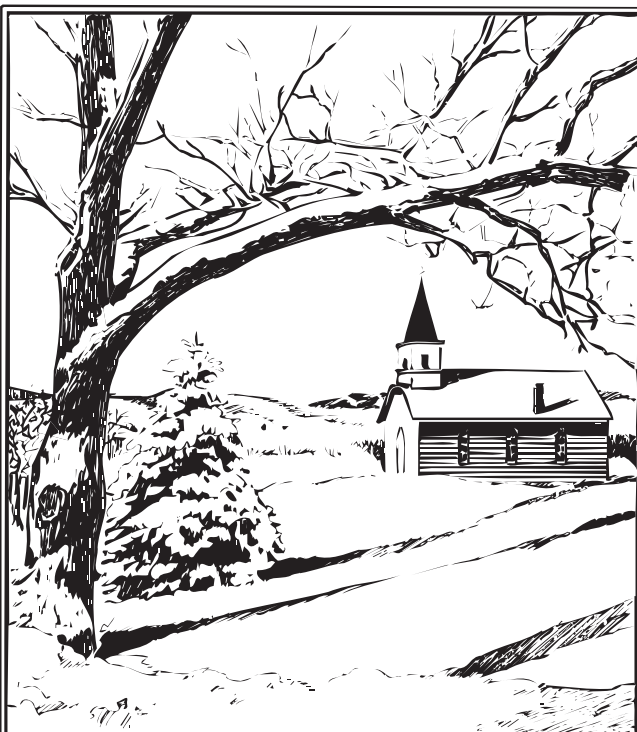
