### RESOLUTION NO. 2012-06 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS, CREATING THE WEST UNION CEMETERY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, has received a proposal requesting that it exercise its power to create a cemetery district to be governed by and subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 17-1330, et seq., and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 17-1373, the Board held a hearing upon such proposal, and, after due notice of such hearing as provided by law, the Board determined that it was in the best interests to establish a cemetery district comprised of the following described territory within Norton County, Kansas, to-wit:

Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Twelve (12), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Five (5) South, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the 6th P.M.; and Sections One (1), Two (2), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36), Township Five (5) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M., all in Norton County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas:

**SECTION ONE:** That a cemetery district be established, and is hereby created, comprised of the following described lands and territory within Norton County, Kansas:

Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Twelve (12), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M.; Sections One (1) through Thirty-six (36), Township Five (5) South, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the 6th P.M.; and Sections One (1), Two (2), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36), Township Five (5) South, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the 6th P.M., all in Norton County, Kansas.

**SECTION TWO:** That said cemetery district shall be governed by and subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 17-1330, et seq., and amendments thereto.

**SECTION THREE:** That, within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution by the Board, the township trustee of Solomon Township shall call a meeting of all the qualified electors of the newly created cemetery district for the purpose of organizing the cemetery district into an association and for the election of five (5) directors who shall have the authority to provide for the care and maintenance of the district cemeteries. Such directors so elected shall hold their office until the next regular meeting of the cemetery association. Directors shall reside within Norton County, Kansas.

**SECTION FOUR:** That the township trustee of Solomon Township shall cause notice of the meeting to organize the cemetery district to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks, in a newspaper of general circulation in the cemetery district stating that a meeting of the qualified voters of such district will be held at the time and place fixed in the notice and to elect five (5) directors. The last publication of the notice shall be made no more than six (6) days prior to the date fixed for the holding of the meeting.

**SECTION FIVE:** This resolution shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official County newspaper. This resolution shall take effect 30 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed by not less than ten percent (10.0%) of the qualified electors in the proposed cemetery district with the County Election Officer requiring a referendum to be held on the resolution as provided by K.S.A. 17-1373, in which case this resolution shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
