ORDINANCE NO. 351
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR THE
USE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS**
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:

Section One. That Section 15-225 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"**RATES.** The rates per month for the use of water in the City shall be as follows:

(a) The water rates for users of water on premises within the City shall be \$29.00 for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum.
(b) The water rates for users of water on premises outside the corporate limits of the City shall be \$29.00 per month for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons over the 3,000 gallon minimum."

Section Two. Ordinance No. 348 is hereby repealed.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 352
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR THE USE OF
SEWER WITHIN THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS**
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:

Section One. That Subsection (d) of Section 15-428 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The following classes of users and charges to those users are hereby established:

CLASS I: Residential Users \$10.00/month;
CLASS II: Business Users \$16.50/month."

Section Two. The provisions of Ordinance No. 287 of the City of Lenora, Kansas, which are inconsistent with the provisions of Section One of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and take effect upon publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 353
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION
AND DISPOSAL CHARGES WITHIN THE CITY OF
LENORA, KANSAS**
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 15-523 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows: the following schedule of charges is hereby established as reasonable and in accordance with the requirements of the County solid waste system and the volume of refuse handled from the following classifications of residences, dwellings and commercial establishments, to-wit:

"**FEE SCHEDULE.**

(a) For each single-family dwelling or each unit of a multiple-family dwelling containing three (3) or less dwelling units within the City, \$14.00 per month will be charged.

(b) For each home-based business, monthly charges shall be \$16.00. For each commercial establishment and each multi-family dwelling containing more than three (3) dwelling units within the City, monthly charges shall be \$22.50. For those establishments or dwelling units utilizing a trash dumpster, the charge shall be \$32.50 per collection. Solid waste placed for collection, which exceeds the capacity of the dumpster at the time of collection will be assessed an extra pick up charge.

(c) Mobile home courts shall be charged fees established in the same manner and at the same rate as commercial establishments; however, for each mobile home that may be serviced individually, the normal residential charge of \$14.00 per month shall apply.

(d) Collection service outside the corporate limits of the City of Lenora using a dumpster shall be charged \$32.50 per month."

SECTION TWO. Ordinances of the City of Lenora, Kansas, in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and shall take effect on May 1, 2012.
