

Varsity golf team places third in I-70 Classic

Playing as well as they have all season, the Norton Community High School varsity golf team took advantage of perfect weather conditions to shoot season-low and career best games and place third in the first annual I-70 Classic held in WaKeeney on Thursday.

Trego was the champion with a 326 and Ellis was just two strokes behind them at 328. Next, came the Blue Jays who were just nine strokes behind with a 337.

Oakley was in fourth with a 338, followed by Ness City, 351; Atwood, 356; Ellinwood, 373; Plainville, 381; Osborne, 386; Hill City, 401.

Originally, the tournament was scheduled to be 36 holes with half played in WaKeeney and half in Ellis but last-minute changes reduced it to 18 holes at WaKeeney.

All six Norton golfers were juniors. Christopher Fisher was low man for the Blue Jays with a 39/41-80, which also earned him a tie for fourth medalist. Next for Norton came Andrew Ellis with a 40/45-85. He was followed by Eli Bozarth and John Risewick, both of whom shot 86s. Bozarth recorded a 42/44 and Risewick shot a con-

sistent 43-43.

Also playing for Norton and their scores were Ryan Bainter, 50/50-100 and Treven Rossi, 51/51-102.

"This was an excellent day for us," said Norton head golf coach David Stover. "We played very well!"

"Today's team score was a 23-stroke improvement over our previous season low!"

"Christopher, Andrew and John all shot career low tournament scores today. We have really worked on developing a more consistent 18-hole round of golf and today was the first time we have begun to see that improvement.

"I am extremely proud of our golfers today and look for continued consistency as the season begins to hit the home stretch."

The Norton varsity golf team competed in the annual Thomas More Prep Invitational on the Smoky Hill golf course in Hays on Monday but results were not available by the Norton Telegram's press time.

The Norton varsity's next competition will be on Thursday in the Colby Invitational, beginning at 3 p.m.

The Norton junior varsity will host the Norton JV Invitational tournament today at the Prairie Dog Golf Association course south of Norton, beginning at 3 p.m.

The Northern Valley Huskies boys track team competed in the Quinter Invitational on April 27 and finished in 11th place with 23 points. The girls team did not compete.

Senior distance-runner Gunnar Hays continued his dominance and winning ways with first place finishes in the 1600m and 3200m run.

"In the 1600 Gunnar was pushed by the runner from Weskan. It helped him (Hays) achieve his best time of the season in some very windy conditions," said head coach Chuck Fessenden.

Sophomore Hunter Chandler has been a steady performer all season for the Huskies. Chandler placed sixth in the high jump with an effort of five feet and eight inches.

"Hunter Chandler continues to be consistent in the high jump at five feet-eight inches. He had some good jumps at five feet-ten inches. Hopefully he will be able to clear that height this week," said coach Fessenden.

Freshman Clint Cole had a break out performance in the pole vault, clearing a height of 10 feet and six inches, which was good enough for a sixth place finish.

"Clint Cole set a personal best in the pole

vault at 10 feet-six inches, and picked up a sixth place finish. Placing in a meet of this size is a nice accomplishment for a freshman," added Fessenden.

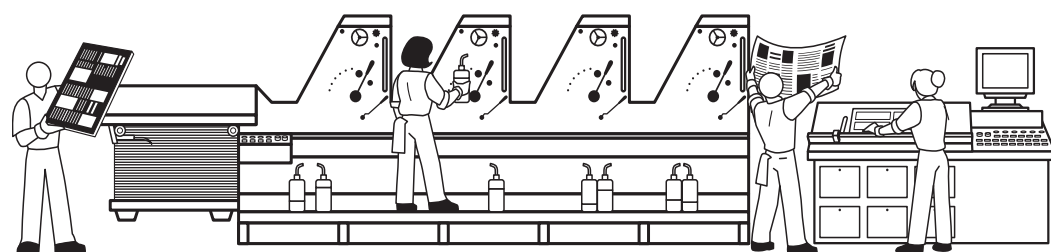
