

Local pastor is celebrating ordination anniversary

Fr. Vincent Thu Laing, Pastor of St. Francis of Assisi and St. Joseph Catholic Churches, is celebrating the 25th anniversary of his ordination with a celebration at St. Francis Assisi on Sunday. Parishoners and friends are invited to join the celebration at a pot luck dinner following the 10:30 a.m. Mass.

The pastor began his duties as pastor at St. Francis of Assisi and St. Joseph in July 1999. In addition to his duties at the two parishes, he has celebrated mass monthly at the Andbe Home and weekly at the Norton Correctional Facility.

He was ordained on April 4, 1987, in Yangon, Burma, for the Diocese of Pathein. In 1999, he arrived in the United States as a missionary to the Diocese of Salina. He has served parishes in Beloit, Washington and Morrowville.

In January, Fr. Vincent traveled to Burma, now known as Myanmar, for sabbatical. During that time, he celebrated the anniversary of his ordination with five priests ordained at the same time. Celebrations occurred in his village and several surrounding villages in which Fr. Vincent spent time as a young priest. During his visit, Fr. Vincent visited with the first couple he married and the first person he baptized.

St. Joseph Parish in New Almelo celebrated the anniversary with Fr. Vincent on April 22.
