**A RESOLUTION FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING ON PUBLIC OFFICER'S REPORT FINDING THE PREMISES OF LESLIE R. AND SALLY L. ELLIS, 335 SOUTH THIRD STREET, LENORA, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS, UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION, DANGEROUS AND UNSAFE**

WHEREAS, the Public Officer of the City of Lenora, Kansas, has made her report and request to the Governing Body of the City of Lenora, Kansas, that finds the premises located within Lenora, Kansas, belonging to Leslie R. and Sally L. Ellis, more particularly described as follows:

The East 75 feet of the South 75 feet of Lot Four (4), Block "H" of Hendrick's Addition to the Town (now City) of Lenora, Norton County, Kansas; to be unfit for human habitation, dangerous and unsafe; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lenora, Kansas, has authority pursuant to Section 4-601, et seq., of Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, to require or cause the repair, closing or demolition or removal of such structures found to be unfit for human habitation, dangerous or unsafe within Lenora, Kansas.

**SECTION TWO:** That this resolution shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper and that notice by certified mail be sent to each owner, agent, lienholder and occupant of the premises.

## SWINE WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT

Pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated, 65-1,179(c) and (d), the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (Department) is requesting the public to review and provide comments for a permit application the Department is currently reviewing. Calvert Swine LLC is proposing to construct a swine waste management system for a 9,300 head swine finishing facility. The facility will consist of two buildings for housing swine, one earthen waste treatment basin, two earthen waste storage basins, and a tree shelter belt.

The facility and land where the facility will be located will be owned and operated by Calvert Swine LLC, 1304 W. Fox Road, Long Island, KS 67647. The facility will be located south of Highway 383 and approximately 2.6 miles southwest of Alma or in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 21 West, Grant Township, Norton County.

The Department is currently reviewing the permit application and supporting information and anticipates continuing the review in the coming weeks. The Department has up to 180 days from the date of this public notice to make a determination to approve or disapprove the issuance of a permit. The Department will be reviewing the application to ensure the requirements for issuance of a permit have been met.

If the Department makes a tentative decision to issue a permit, then the Department will prepare a draft

permit and a second public notification will be made in the Kansas register which is available at [www.kssos.org/Pubs/pubs\\_kansas\\_register.asp](http://www.kssos.org/Pubs/pubs_kansas_register.asp) or the Northwest Kansas Library System, 2 Washington Square, Norton, KS 67654. The notification will advise the public a draft permit has been prepared and the Department will request the public to review and provide comments concerning the draft permit.

Some of the application documents, a document summarizing the requirements for the permit and permit application, and the Fact Sheet required by K.S.A. 65-1,179(b) are available for review on the internet at [www.kdheks.gov/feedlots](http://www.kdheks.gov/feedlots) (fourth bullet - "Swine Applications"). Complete documentation, including the remainder of the permit application, and the document summarizing the requirements is available for review at the KDHE Northwest District Office, 2301 E 13th Street, Hays, KS 67601-2851, at the office of the Norton County Clerk, 105 South Kansas, Norton, Kansas 67654, and at the KDHE Main Office in Topeka (address below).

Comments on the permit application should be sent to the Department as soon as possible but no later than 30 days from this notice. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORCATUL, KANSAS:**

**Section One.** Pursuant to the powers granted to cities under KSA 48-932 we do hereby consent to the Mayor's order and declaration that an emergency exists or is imminent and that the discharge of fireworks within the City of Norcatul is hereby prohibited.

**Section Two.** The Mayor's order shall be and remain in effect until dissolved by the governing body.

**Section Three.** Pursuant to KSA 48-939 a violation of this order is a class A misdemeanor punishable by up to 1 year in jail and/or a fine of up to \$2500.
