Calvert Swine LLC is proposing to construct a swine waste management system for a 9,300 head swine finishing facility. The facility will consist of two buildings for housing swine, one earthen waste treatment basin, two earthen waste storage basins, and a tree shelter belt.

The facility and land where the facility will be located will be owned and operated by Calvert Swine LLC, 1304 W. Fox Road, Long Island, KS 67647. The facility will be located south of Highway 383 and approximately 2.6 miles southwest of Almena or in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19. Township 2 South, Range 21 West, Grant Township, Norton County.

The Department is currently reviewing the permit application and supporting information and anticipates continuing the review in the coming weeks. Section Three. Pursuant to KSA 48-939 a violation of this order is a class A misdemeanor punishable by up to 1 year in jail and/or a fine of up to \$2500.
