RESOLUTION NO. 5-2012

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY AND INSTITUTING A BURN BAN PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 48-932

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS, that the following be adopted:

Under the authority vested in the Mayor, and with the consent of the City Council of the City of Norton, Kansas and pursuant to K.S.A. 48-932, and in order to take such measures as are necessary for the proper and necessary preservation and protection of property, a burn ban is issued to take effect immediately for the City of Norton, Kansas.

WHEREFORE, it is found that Norton County, Kansas is currently suffering from drought conditions, which greatly increase the risk of fires and other emergencies. That the Kansas State Fire Marshal has warned of the fire hazards associated with extreme heat and dry conditions across the state.

WHEREAS, the outdoor burning or the discharge of any fireworks, whether or not controlled, greatly distress the risk of dangerous and potentially harmful fires.

WHEREAS, under the power vested in the Governing body of Norton, Kansas it is resolved that effective on this 2nd day of July, 2012, in accordance with K.S.A. 48-932, that the City of Norton, Kansas is declared to be in a state of extreme fire emergency, and all outdoor burning, the discharge, shooting or firing of fireworks is prohibited.

WHEREAS, the City of Norton is suspending open and recreational burning until further notice. That such ban includes the physical shooting or firing of fireworks within the City Limits during the ban. Outdoor grilling is permitted, but grillers are urged to use extreme caution and to be sure to have the means to suppress a fire.

WHEREAS, this ban will be in effect until further notice and will remain in effect until our area receives appreciable rainfall.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 48-939, the knowing and willful violation of this ban shall constitute a Class A misdemeanor and subject the person to an order to appear in court.

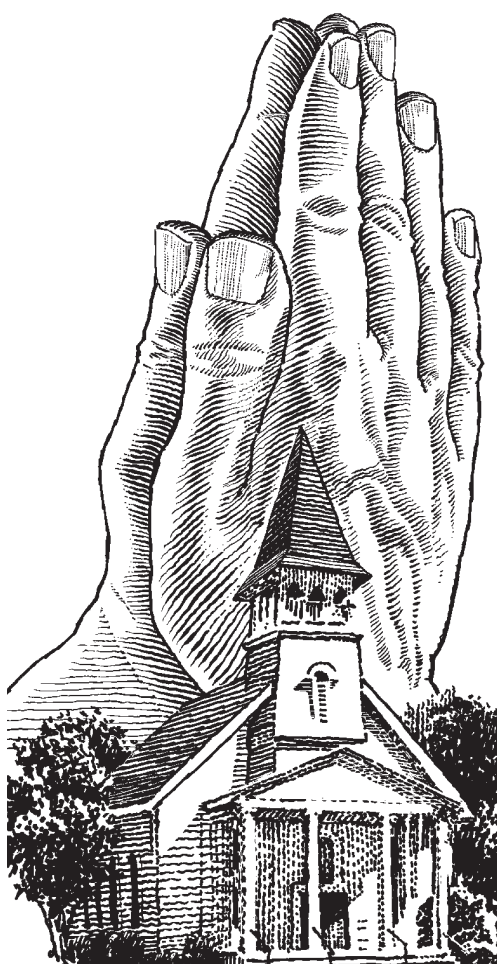
