

Legion defeats Phillipsburg twice

The Norton American Legion baseball team won two close games, one in extra innings, on Thursday, July 5 in Phillipsburg. Norton edged Phillipsburg 6-5 in the opener by scoring five runs in the top of the fifth and final inning, then broke a 3-all game with six runs in the top of the eighth inning to win the nightcap, 9-3.

Both teams had three runs at the end of regulation in the nightcap but the Blue Jays scored six big runs in the top of the eighth inning to win 9-3. Norton tallied one run in the top of the first when Millan doubled and scored later in the inning. The Panthers tied it at 1-all with a run in the bottom of the first. Two more runs by Norton in the top of the second made it 3-1 in favor of the visitors. Trever Lewis, John Risewick and Lane Bigge singled in succession and Nickell got on base on a fielder's choice. Lewis and Risewick both scored.

First game
In the opener, Norton took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning when Trey Millan doubled and scored later in the inning. Phillipsburg scored twice in the bottom of the first to make it 2-1.

Phillipsburg scored once more in the bottom of the fourth to cut the Norton lead to 3-2, then added one more run in the bottom of the sixth to tie the score at 3-all. Neither team scored in the seventh inning.

Neither team scored again until the Blue Jays ran five runs across home plate in the top of the fifth to lead 6-2. Jacob Brooks and John Risewick both singled, Toby Nickell doubled, Millan singled, Dakota Dreher got on base with an error, Dalton Miller doubled and Tug Keiswetter singled. All except Miller and Keiswetter scored.

In the top of the extra eighth inning, the Blue Jays took advantage of walks and errors and just two hits to score six runs with two down and take a 9-3 lead. Risewick and Bigge both made it on base on errors, Nickell doubled and Brooks walked. Millan was hit by a pitch and advanced, then Dreher and Miller both walked and Keiswetter doubled. All except Miller and Keiswetter scored.

The Panthers' rally fell one run short in the bottom of the fifth when they tallied three times to make the final Norton 6, Phillipsburg 5.

The Blue Jays had eight hits, eight walks and eight strike outs. Leading hitters for Norton were Millan and Lewis, both of whom went 2 for 4 with the bat.

Norton had seven hits, no walks and four strike outs. Leading hitter for the Blue Jays was Millan, who went 2 for 3 with the bat. Miller, Keiswetter, Brooks, Risewick and Nickell each had one hit.

Tug Keiswetter pitched five innings for Norton and was the winning pitcher. He game up three hits, two walks and struck out six

Trey Millan pitched for Norton. He gave up six hits, walked two and struck out 11 batters.

Seth Derr was the losing pitcher.

batters. Dalton Miller relieved him for the last three innings. He allowed no hits, walked three and struck out five batters.

Hunter Kohler, who relieved Brock Morgan on the mound after six and two-thirds innings, was the losing pitcher.

Coach's comments

"We finally got some timely hitting tonight, especially from Lane Bigge," said Norton head coach Scott Ellis.

"Trey, Tug and Dalton all pitched very well.

"Our defense tonight was not good but we managed to win both games."

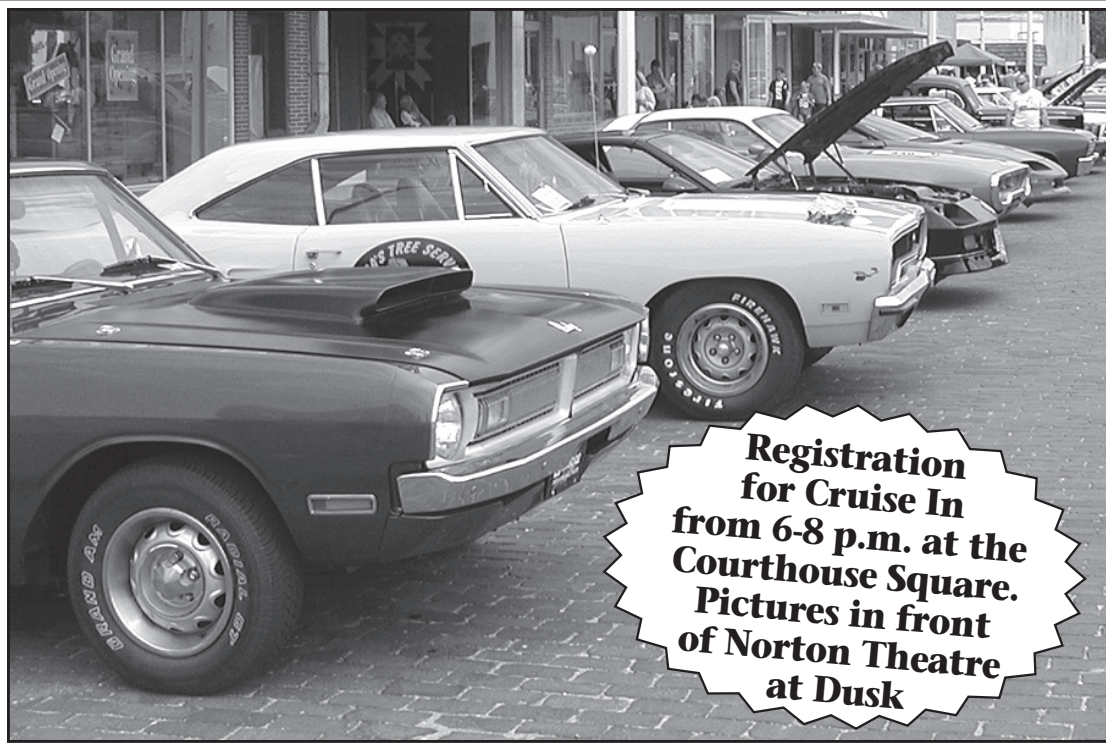
