They are Brock Lauer, senior at Hastings College; Kaid McKenna, sophomore at Hastings College; Terrell Lane, sophomore at Hutchinson Community College; Zane Perez, sophomore at Colorado School of Mines in Golden, Colo. and Luke Ninemire, sophomore at Highland Community College.

Brock Lauer

Brock Lauer is a senior member of the Hastings College football team.

A 6'190 pounder, he plays inside linebacker where he is fighting for a starting position this

Brock has been a steady member of the Hastings team and has worked hard to become a starter.

The Broncos have a young defense and experienced offense and have their sights set on a conference championship.

His prep career at Norton Community High School was outstanding. He was an All-Mid-Continent League selection on both offense and defense by league coaches and also received All-State honors from the large daily newspapers in

Brock was also an outstanding wrestler and track athlete for the Blue Jays. He was a wrestling state tournament competitor his junior and senior

He was an All-Mid-Continent League selection by league coaches and received many post-season accolades from large daily newspapers in Kan-

Kaid was also an outstanding wrestler and was a state wrestling medal winner.

The former all-state running back from Norton, Terrell Lane fit right in with the Hutchinson Blue

Dragons of the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference in his freshman season last year. He was the second leading rusher for the team, picking up 461 yards and averaging 6.3 yards per

He scored nine touchdowns, including two runs of 60 or more yards, one going for 85 yards. Ter-

rell also excelled on special teams where he had a punt return for a touchdown and averaged 16.2 yards per kickoff return. He also blocked two

He is going into the fall as the starting tailback. The 5'11", 220 pound Terrell was an all-state, all-league performer who lettered for four years at Norton Community High School. His senior season, he ran for 1,766 yards on 148 carries for an average of 11.93 yards per carry. He also gained 2,278 all purpose yards his senior season as he also returned punts and kickoffs.

Terrell also played for the victorious West Team in the annual Kansas Shrine Bowl All-Star foot-

In his four years as a running back for Norton, Terrell gained 5,011 yards and rushed for 59 touchdowns.

He was also a starting guard on Norton's basketball team and a Blue Jay track letterman.

Terrell's mother is Heidi Lane Davis, his grandmother is Patty Fisher and his great-grandmother is Lila Fisher.

Zane Perez

Zane Perez was an outstanding football player and wrestler for Norton Community High School and was also a letterman in track.

He is 5'10" and 190 pounds and is beginning his third year as a member of the Colorado School of Mines football team in Golden, Colo.

Since he redshirted one year, he is a sophomore in eligibility.

Zane was a first team all-league selection as a fullback on offense and defensive back during his senior year for the Blue Jays and also received post-season honors from the large daily newspapers in Kansas. He was also a state medal winner for the NCHS wrestling team.

He was converted from running back to defensive back at School of Mines prior to last season. Zane is fighting for a starting position at corner-

During the Spring Game this past April, he was

sharing the No.1 spot with another player. Zane is the son of Kelli and Rudy Perez.

Luke Ninemire


Luke Ninemire, a former rugged offensive and defensive lineman for Norton, played inside linebacker for Highland Community College.
