RESOLUTION NO. 2012-18

A RESOLUTION INITIATING THE PROCESS OF AMENDING THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PLAN FOR NORTON COUNTY AND NOTICE OF HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17,114, et seq., the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, adopted a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan on November 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17,114, et seq., the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, adopted a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan on November 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Norton County to remain competitive and progressive in promoting potential business opportunities and residential housing development; and

WHEREAS, the Board proposes to amend the Plan in the following respects:

Remove the cap for commercial improvements. Currently, the caps are set at \$50,000 for residential and \$250,000 for commercial.

Allow incentives to be transferred. This would allow a bona fide developer who sells a property shortly after completion the ability to transfer the tax abatements to the purchaser.

Amend the Valuation and Application fee structure. The chart below describes the proposed increases in application fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, that a hearing before the Board shall be held on the 15th day of October, 2012, at ten o'clock (10:00) a.m. in the Commissioners' Chambers, second floor, Norton County Courthouse in Norton, Kansas, to determine whether the proposed amendments to the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan should be adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution and Notice of Hearing shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official County newspaper.

The City Council of the City of Norton, Kansas (the "City"), has heretofore, pursuant to Resolution No. 6-2012 adopted on August 1, 2012, declared it advisable to conduct a special question election relating to the imposition of a three-quarter percent (0.75%) City-wide general purpose retailers' sales tax.

Shall the following be adopted:

Shall the City of Norton, Kansas be authorized to impose a three-quarter percent (0.75%) city-wide general purpose retailers' sales tax, the revenue from which will be applied to finance the costs to construct and equip a City swimming pool project, to pay the costs of operating and maintaining that swimming pool and to finance general operating and capital improvement expenses of the City, with collection of such sales tax to commence on April 1, 2013 or as soon thereafter as permitted by law, and to terminate twenty (20) years from the date of commencement, all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended?
