He was head track coach and assistant football coach at Fowler High School for three years before moving to Norton. He was a teacher and assistant football and track coach in Norton for four years before becoming head track and field coach.

"We are excited that practice has begun," said coach Jones.

"With 49 total athletes and 22 returning letter winners, we have a nice core group of experienced leaders returning.

"We are off to a solid start in practice. We will look towards the early meets to provide us with competitive baselines and those meets will offer our girls and boys who have been working hard a chance to compete and have some fun. We cannot wait to open the competitive season!"

Ambrosier brought home the gold medal from the state meet with a vault of 9'6". Melvin was fourth in the discus with a throw of 116'6" and fifth in the shot with a heave of 35'7". Nickell placed third in the shot with a distance of 35'11.25" and the 4 x 800 meter relay placed fourth in 10:20.90.
