 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Governing Body that the recommendation approving said zoning change shall be adopted.  
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:**  
 Section 1: That this amendment of the City Zoning Code is pursuant to the Norton City Code 16-316 and the Norton City Code 16-320.  
 Section 2: That the following change shall be approved and that the zoning district shall be changed from Multiple Dwelling District to Light Industrial District as to the property located at:  
 813 N. Grant, Norton, Kansas, and more specifically described as: Lot Fourteen (14) and a tract commencing at the Northeast Corner of Lot Thirteen (13), running thence South Twelve feet, thence West 36 feet, thence North 12 feet, Thence East 36 feet to the place of beginning, all in Block Three (3) of North Addition to the City of Norton, Norton County, Kansas.  
 Section 3: That any ordinance in conflict herewith shall be repealed.  
 Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
